Grounds Maintenance Worker – Physical Plant

Work Performed:

- 1. Provides leadership to mowing and/or lawn maintenance crew.
- 2. Perform grounds maintenance activities; lawn mowing, trimming, irrigation, exterior plantings, walks and brick walkways, snow removal and de-icing, etc. including operation and maintenance of grounds equipment, forklift, dump truck, etc.
- 3. Parking and traffic control structure maintenance; barricades, street drains, pavement maintenance, parking bumpers, etc.
- 4. Acquisition and maintenance of appropriate Commercial Driver's License (CDL) for the operation of Trash Compactor truck; picking up refuse and delivery to the landfill. Responsible for handling and storage of Biohazardous Waste.
- 5. Required to work in a physical nature outside with grounds crew, to include all the above mention tasks.
- 6. Other duties as assigned by the Physical Plant.

Requirements:

- 1. Minimum one-year experience in grounds maintenance work; or equivalent combinations of applicable experience.
- 2. High School diploma, G.E.D, and/or years of grounds maintenance experience.
- 3. Interpret and work rough sketches, drawings, and blueprints, and follow both verbal and written instructions.
- 4. Ability to instruct assistants, and provide leadership for seasonal and part-time employees/
- 5. Understand and follow all safety procedures and use of safety equipment
- 6. Maintain a positive working relationship with co-workers, faculty & staff, students, and the general public; will be required to work as a member of other trade crews on large projects.
- 7. Operate vehicle and possess a valid driver's license. CDL with appropriate classification for the operation of the trash compactor truck is required.
- 8. May work under emergency and difficult situations.
- 9. Experience and comfortable working in heights with agility and balance, on scaffolding, ladders, and lifts.
- 10. Able to respond to emergency call-ins and may be required to work weekends/holidays as needed on snow removal, storm damage, special activities, etc.
- 11. Skilled in the operation and use of tools, chemicals, materials, and equipment in the grounds maintenance area with a good mechanical background.
- 12. Knowledge of lawn, grounds, and construction equipment operation and maintenance; i.e. Bobcat, forklift, etc.
- 13. May be required to perform weekend/holiday building checks and respond to pager calls.
- 14. Provide instruction to assistants and assist with training of new co-workers.
- 15. This person will assist in all areas as deemed necessary by the Director of Physical Plant.

Working Conditions:

- 1. Standing, bending, climbing, carrying, reaching, handling, and use of fingers 50% or more of the work day. Combination of heavy truck operation and manual labor activities.
- 2. Regular attendance is required for this position. Actual schedule contingent upon the needs of the department and Vincennes University.
- 3. Works both indoors and outdoors, occasionally under inclement weather conditions.
- 4. Frequently lifting 50-100 pounds or over.
