**Essential Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Play a pivotal role in the expansion of the VU John Deere, Diesel Technology and Power Generation programs.
- Strong background and experience repairing John Deere and/or other agricultural machinery including tractors, harvesters, sprayers, balers, planters, and various other implements.
- Give guidance to students as they complete lab assignments demonstrating skills in preventative maintenance, troubleshooting, and problem-solving mechanical issues in John Deere equipment and other machinery.
- Be knowledgeable in hydraulics, electrical (basic and advanced), diesel engines, HVAC, powertrain, preventive maintenance, and steering and suspension systems of industrial or John Deere agriculture equipment.
- Ability to communicate with students during various stages of the learning process and to reach each student at his/her maximum learning potential.
- Organize and present prepared instructional materials at scheduled times and places.
- Preserve communications with students and colleagues to assure efficient and effective instruction.

2. Associate's degree in Diesel Technology or related area plus a minimum of five years full time, documented industry experience and applicable ASE or industry specific certifications or ability to complete.
3. Related course disciplines/experiences within: Diesel Technology, Agricultural Mechanization, Diesel Management, Diesel Service Technology, Diesel Engineering, Automotive Technology and a minimum of

eight years full time, documented experience in the field of Diesel, Agricultural Equipment, or Automotive Technology plus applicable ASE or industry specific certifications.
