- 7. Meet Emotional, Cognitive and Physical essential functions of the position.
- 8. Sign job description and mentor checklist for personnel file and submit to the appropriate chair

Minimum Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities Required.

- 1. Meets requirements set forth by accrediting agencies (HLC, ACEN, ISBN, ISDH), clinical agencies and Vincennes University. These academic criteria are the same as, or comparable to, that required for appointment as a full-time faculty.
- 2. NURS/NURP lab/clinical BSN pursing either qualified nurse education certificate, or master's degree in nursing. MSN Preferred.
 - CNA lab/clinical RN with documentation of completion a "Train the Trainer" course for teaching adults
- 3. Previous teaching/clinical experience (3 years) desired.
- 4. Requires communication and interpersonal skills for interacting effectively with students, peers, and clinical agencies to provide an environment conducive to students learning.
